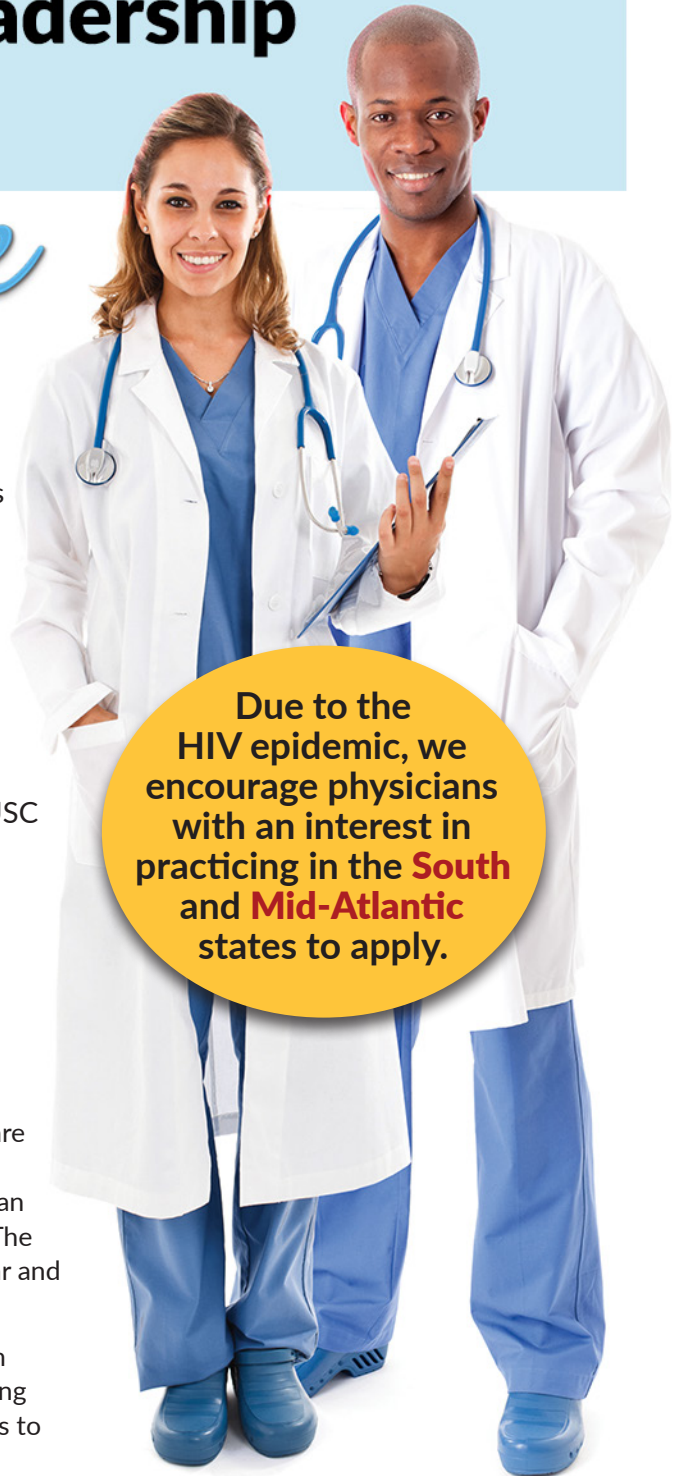




# HIV Clinical Leadership Program

Once we receive your completed application, we may contact you for an interview. Final cohort selection will be completed by **November 30**. The fellowship program may accept up to four qualified candidates per year and begins on **July 1** each year.

Ideal candidates are board-eligible graduates of a residency program in Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, or Medicine-Pediatrics with a strong interest in HIV medicine or an interest in building community programs to improve access to quality HIV care.
